The Winter 2006 Lutheran Woman's Quarterly featured an article "Treasure Up" by our own Velma Bass, past Kansas District LWML President, based on Luke 2:19.

An Executive Committee Transition meeting was held in Salina on May 6, 2006, followed by a Special EC Transition Meeting of the Standing Committees also at Salina on June 3, 2006.

Lutheran Family Retreat took place at Webster Conference Center, Salina, on August 4-6, 2006 under the theme: "Glorify the Lord With Me."

Executive Board, Board of Directors and Kansas Assembly of Leaders met at Camp Webster, Salina, Ks. on September 7, 8, and 9, 2006, with the theme: "Chosen to Lead." The Goal was continued: "To prepare LWML leaders of the Kansas District to serve God while growing together in Christ." Mission Statement: "Empowered by the Holy Spirit, the Kansas District LWML will nurture, motivate, and prepare LCMS women to serve the Lord with gladness." Proposed focus area vision statements for 2006-2008 were also continued: Effective Communication, Leadership training, and Service to Others, were identified. Ingathering at the Assembly of Leaders was given to the Salina Food Pantry.

MMV Consultants, Eden Keefe and Tammy Songer led power point presentations on leadership. Donna Burton reviewed for the group her mission trip to Alaska with LCMS Missions director, Bob Roegner and his assistant An exciting addition to LWML announced was the Teen LWML under the logo: "Friends Into Serving Him." Materials for Teens were made available through the LWML store to be distributed at the time of LWML Sunday in October 2006.

Plans for the 32nd Biennial Kansas District LWML Convention to be held in Topeka, Kansas, at Capital Plaza Hotel on April 11-13, 2008 were discussed. "Joy in the Journey, Nehemiah 8:10, was to be the theme. Lois Llewellyn and Carole Feek representing the Topeka Zone and the N.E. Zone were announced as the convention chairs. Mission Project Committee reported that Financial Aid was dispersed to 48 (synodical college students and 9 seminarians) applicants for a total of \$19,100.

LWML Sunday, October 2006, service theme was: "Let There Be Light," based on the text of John 8:12, authored by Rev. Charles S. Mueller, Sr., Pastor Emeritus of Trinity Lutheran Church, Roselle, Illinois

The Day of Prayer Service 2007 offerings recipient was God's Storehouse in Burlington, Kansas. The theme verses (Psalm 31:1-3) was the basis for the theme, "Between a Rock and a Hard Place - A Good Place!" authored by Rev. Dan Heuer, LWML Counselor 2001-2005. The total offering given to the recipient was \$2743.91.

Spring Tour Speakers were Ken and Muriel Green, Lutheran World Relief Leaders, Coordinators and volunteers for 22 years. They presented "Uncounted Blessings." The presentation of Ken's travel slides set to verse of Holy Scriptures inspired attendees to join LWR's work of reaching out to those in need.

Our LWML sister and Kansas District President from 1988-92, Jane Turner, died on March 4, 2007, at the age of 79. Her memorial service was held at Redeemer Lutheran Church, Olathe on March 8, 2007. Jane co-chaired the International Convention in Kansas City in 1995 and then served on the International Board of Directors. She also served on the Kansas District LCMS Board of Directors and the Lutheran Braille Workers board.

The 32nd Biennial Convention of the Lutheran Women's Missionary League was held in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, June 21-24, 2007, with the theme: "Rest on Christ the King." One hundred seventy-five Kansans were among the 5000 in attendance. A new record mite goal was approved: \$1,700,000 for 18 mission grants to fund two medical facilities in Sudan, two deaconesses in Africa, train deaf ministry leaders, to support a soup kitchen at St. Matthew Lutheran Church in Chicago, and many others. The 65th anniversary offering totaled \$89,327.25. Total offerings received as of 7/11/07 were \$236,089.45, which were given to the LWML Endowment Fund, Missionary Children's Education, Seminary student aid divided between the seminaries at Ft. Wayne and St. Louis and continued funding for the Heart-to-Heart program. Ten thousand "Gifts from the Heart" ingathering (quilts, towel sets, health kits) were packed and delivered to agencies in Sioux Falls as well as Orphan Grain Train. Young Women representatives (YWR) from Kansas were Lauren Delaney, Olathe, and Debra Rose, Wichita, who walked with our President Judy Carlson carrying the Kansas convention banner designed and made by Tammy Songer, KC Crossroads Zone. Teens, ages 11-17, numbering 91, enjoyed a Teen Hang Out making pet rocks designing cards for the Children's Hospital in Sioux Falls, played Bible Jeopardy and had a rockin' good time as Friends Into Serving Him.

Dr. Mary Manz Simon, Terri Kieschnick, The Rev. Dr. Dean Nadasdy, and the Rev. Dr. Robert Roegner, were featured speakers at the convention. Outgoing LWML President Linda Reiser welcomed newly elected 16th LWML President Jan Wendorf. Delegates chose Des Moines, Iowa, as the site of the 2015 Convention. Other upcoming conventions are planned for Portland, Oregon in 2009, Peoria, Illinois, in 2011, and Pittsburg, Pa, in 2013.

Lutheran Family Retreat, August 3-5, 2007, met at Camp Webster, Salina, under the theme: "Rest on the Christ the King."

Kansas Assembly of Leaders and Board of Directors met at Camp Webster Conference Center, September 7-8, 2007, with the theme: "ROCK: Rest on Christ the King" to study the Word and learn together about leadership. The Kansas District Mission Statement again was the focus of all KAOL planning and discussion: "Empowered by the Holy Spirit, Kansas District Lutheran Women's Missionary League will nurture, motivate and prepare LCMS women to serve the Lord with gladness." District and zone leaders gave \$901.53 to mites during the two-day meeting plus an ingathering of necessary items for the Salina Rescue Mission. Each Zone Mission Projects

representative designed a Mite calendar page while in session at KAOL. The calendar was made available on the Kansas LWML web site. Only two 2006-2008 mission projects were yet to be paid by the time of KAOL in September.

Dr. Dale Meyer, former Lutheran Hour Speaker and current President of Concordia Seminary, St. Louis, was author of LWML Sunday 2007 materials continuing with our convention theme: Rest on Christ the King.

A Christian Life Retreat event took place at Wichita Airport Hilton, Wichita, on November 9-10, 2007, with speaker, Phylllis Wallace. "Joy....is an inside Job," sections were presented by Phyllis on Friday evening and Saturday. The event was sponsored by the Kansas District LWML Christian Growth Committee: Debbie Lehman, Noreen Peterson, Connie Brauer, Cathi Temple and Karen Eskew.

The 2008 Day of Prayer service, "Stepping Out in Faith," was authored by Rev. Barry J. Keurulainen, senior Pastor of St. Luke's Lutheran Church, Cabot, PA, and proclaimer for the opening communion service at the 2005 Tampa LWML convention. The Day of Prayer offering was designated to the Lay Leadership Training Institute, Kansas District LCMS, which amounted to \$2786.32.

LWML Zones held their own Spring Rallies and supplied their own speakers throughout the state.

President Judy Carlson visited as many Zones as possible and gave her Spring 2008 President's

Report: Special thanks were conveyed through our president from the LCMS mission staff for our generous and continued support of Missions through the world with our mites and our quilts. She announced with celebration that all mission projects for the 2006-2008 biennium are paid. This includes financial aid of \$36,000 to 38 students preparing for full time church work. The last two projects paid were: For the Sake of the Church (\$3,000) and the University Lutheran Center Association (Wichita) partial pay: \$700). To God be all Honor and Glory! New items are added and updated on our web site: www.kansaslwml.org or www.kansaslwml.homestead.com. The Christian Growth Committee has announced the next Christian Life Retreat for November 13-14, 2009, with Annetta Dellinger as the presenter. The theme will be "In the Potter's Hands," based on Isaiah 18:16.

Our President, Judy's photo appeared in the Spring 2008 Lutheran Woman's Quarterly, with the artlcle: "Painting the Portrait of LWML," by Marilyn McClure. The article features the LWML Heart to Heart Sisters program which began in 2001. Judy was appointed to the National LWML Structure Committee for 2007-2009. Also in the Spring issue of the Quarterly, National LWML Committee member, Eden Keefe, from Kansas, appears on page 24 with the Christian Resource Editors.

The 32nd Biennial LWML Kansas District Convention was held at the Capital Plaza Hotel

in Topeka, April 11-13, 2008. The Convention goal statement was: "Renewed and restored by God's grace, we have joy in the journey." "Joy in the Journey," based on Nehemiah 8:10 was the theme and subject of the daily Bible Studies led by Pastors Keith Kohlmeier, Timmothy Heath and Jeffrey Crane. The convention was hosted by the Topeka and Northeast Zone LWML with Lois Llewellyn, Lawrence, and Carole Feek, Sabetha, co-chairman Four hundred seventy-three members and guests registered including 80 first time attendees, 11 Young Women Representatives and 4 LWML Teens. Communion services were held at St. John's Lutheran Church, Topeka, with Pastor Rick Rostek as Proclaimer and Rev. Peter Lange, Liturgist. An organ recital by Rev. Roger Goetz preceded the service. An all district choir praised the Lord with singing directed by Susan Akin. Judy Carlson, District President, opened the convention followed by a processional featuring banners depicting the theme from each of the Zones in Kansas. The 32nd Biennial Convention Theme banner was designed by Tammy Songer, and crafted by Jeannie Merrit, Immanuel Lutheran, Lawrence. Singing was led by Pastor Don Wharton, Ft. Wayne, Indiana, along with Rev. David Hutson who kept the Spirit going throughout the convention as the "theme weaver."

Special speakers were Marlene Kohlmeier, wife of Kansas District LCMS President, Keith Kohlmeier; Janice Wendorf, LWML President; Kristy Grannis, Mission Projects Administrator LCMS World Mission; Melissa Salomon, Heart to Heart Sisters and Director of Lutheran Hour Ministries, Mexico; Pam Nummela, Faith Milestones; and Will and Patricia Main, Haskell LIGHT. Insight session presenters were: Pat Bilow, LWML Gift Planning Counselor; Joanna Hadle, Faithbooking; Kathy Jackson, Piece Makers; Esther Ideker, Joy in the in the 65-Year Journey-a Glimpse of our Kansas District "First Ladies;" and LWML 101 and Teen LWML by the Member Development Committee. Servant Events were under the direction of Ramie Schulteis, Chairman of the Care and Needs Committee.

The evening banquet speaker was Don Wharton, singer, composer and humorist. Birthday cake was served to commemorate the 65th Anniversary of the LWML. 65th Anniversary "Official Sponsors" of the convention were provided by "The M and M's, a.k.a. Mary and Marlene.

Gifts from the heart ingathering included personal items for the Topeka Rescue Mission, cancer caps for St. Francis Cancer Center, preemie baby outfits and pediatric quilts for Stormont-Vail Hospital, and twelve quilts for Haskell LIGHT.

Planning Committee members for the 2010 Kansas District LWML Convention JoAnn Meyer, Chairman, and Arlyce Klipp, Vice-Chairman were introduced to the assembly. The the theme of the Kansas District LWMLConvention, to be held at Junction City, is "The Lord is My Strength and My Shield," Psalm 144:2.

The first convention offering was given to Mission Projects in the amount of \$4,777.00; the Second Convention offering to LCMS Armed Forces Ministry given was \$3,772.88; the 65th Anniversary Offering for Special Scholarship Fund in the amount of \$3,213.25; and the Mission Walk for Heart to Heart Sisters in the amount of \$2,184.50.

Delegates to the 2008 Convention approved a work program of \$40,000 to fund mission projects, \$40,000 to provide financial aid to students preparing for full-time parish ministry and \$32,250 projected mites to LWML.
